Largest Virginia Powerball winners:

- Darrell Burnette of Willis won \$2 million with a <u>single ticket</u> in the August 18, 2012 drawing, using Power Play.
- Virginia Fike of Berryville won \$2 million with <u>two tickets</u> in the April 7, 2012 drawing. Each ticket was was worth \$1 million.

Stores that sell a jackpot-winning Powerball ticket in Virginia receive a \$50,000 bonus from the Virginia Lottery.

First day of Powerball sales in Virginia: January 31, 2012. First drawing to include Virginia: February 3, 2010.

Record Powerball jackpot to date: \$365 million on February 18, 2006. It was one ticket, split by eight co-workers in Nebraska.

The largest Powerball jackpot since Virginia joined the game was \$336 million on February 11, 2012. On that day, Virginia Lottery players bought an estimated 1.1 million tickets – at peak times, an estimate 1,860 tickets per minute statewide.
